*57 Wall Street*- THE STUDIO OF SANDRA CORPORA

Visit the beautiful painting-filled studio of award winning, nationally known oil painter Sandra Corpora. The studio was completely rebuilt on the footprint of the previous one-story garage transforming it into a charming carriage house style building. Now this inspiring art studio features a nearly 20 foot ceiling and north facing windows. The space is further enhanced by custom woodwork details. Filling the walls are oil paintings done on location around the world and locally. Also you'll see larger landscapes, still life's and figurative studio paintings.

*265 E. Broad Street*- THE STUDIO OF ANTHONY VISCARDI

Anthony Viscardi, Artist and Professor of Architecture at Lehigh University, moved his art studio to its temporary location, the former Wyandotte Cleaners, in May 2017, following the conclusion of his solo exhibition at the Allentown Museum. A portion of Shadow Landings, the 9' x 55' sculptural work commissioned for that exhibition, is installed in the studio, along with a selection of drawings, prints, and sculptural works from his Tracing Time to Measure Space series.

Viscardi is a nationally and internationally known scholar-teacher in the design and art of architecture and has exhibited his art widely. His work ranges from theoretically based investigations of the shadow as generator of form to sketches from Italy. He is the recipient of a number of artist's fellowships, including the prestigious MacDowell Colony Fellowship.
